Dear Parents

The children have shown excellent learning behaviours this week as we are now well into the Autumn Term. I have had really positive feedback from the staff about how hard the children are working and supporting each other. Long may this continue!

Y4/5/6 Online Safety

Earlier this week, some of our older children visited JCG to listen to a visiting speaker focussing on online safety. The session was very informative and shared lots of advice about keeping safe online and making sure any apps are used sensibly and safely. If you haven't already done so, ask your child to share some of the key learning from the session.

Rights Respecting School Council

Next Friday (26th) we will be holding the elections for our new Rights Respecting School Council members. All children who wish to put themselves forward for this role of responsibility will bring an application form home to complete. They will then need to write a short speech to explain to their class, why they should be chosen as a representative. Elections will take place on the Friday and two children from each class will be elected. Results will be announced soon after the voting.

Reminders

Please can I respectfully remind all parents and families that the school staff car park is not to be used for dropping off or collecting children, other than for breakfast club drop-off. We need to keep this area car free from 8.15am – 8.30am and 2.30pm – 3.00pm so it is safe for families to enter/exit the site using the main gate. I have also been asked by St Saviours Parish Honorary Police to remind you that parking on Byron Lane, opposite school gates is not permitted. There is a clear yellow line which indicates no parking or stopping. I appreciate that drop off and collection can be busy but please use the Monterey Hotel car park or Springfield Stadium (yellow disk) for short stay parking. Please can you share this information with other family members that may also drop-off or pick up your children. Thank you for helping to keep the children safe.

Breakfast Club

If you are dropping off your child in a car for breakfast club, please use a space in the car park and not block the entry to one or two spaces. Staff are arriving for work at this time and access needs to be maintained at all times.


HSA – Home School Association
