

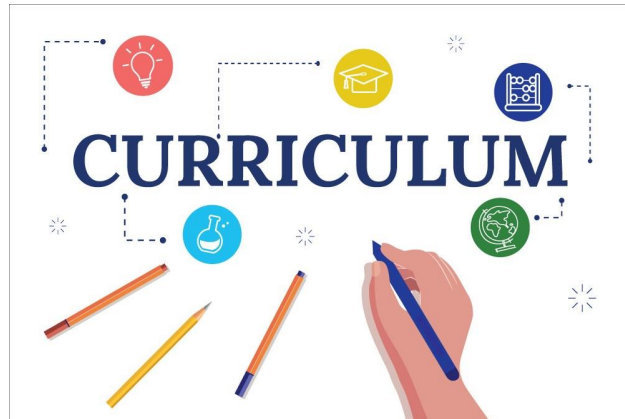


Springfield School Newsletter 17.10.25
