

JERSEY PREMIUM APPLICATION

If you arrived in Jersey within the last 5 years, your child's school could receive Jersey Premium funding.

Jersey Premium helps children to get the best from their education. Your child's school could receive extra funding through Jersey Premium to boost their learning. Schools choose to use Jersey Premium Funding in different ways, depending on what would help children most.

Who is eligible?

- Children from households claiming Income Support;
- **Children who live in a 'Registered' household that *could* receive Income Support (i.e. the household meets the requirements of Income Support) but they have lived in Jersey for less than five years;**
- Children who are (or have ever been) Looked After Children (i.e. who are under the care of the Government of Jersey)

What you need to do

If you have **lived in Jersey for less than 5 years** AND believe you would otherwise qualify for Income Support, please answer the questions below. If you need help completing the form, please speak to your child's school. Your answers will help us to establish whether your child is eligible for Jersey Premium funding. We will let you know if you are eligible or not and also inform your child's school.

A **household** is defined as follows:

- a single parent or couple (married, unmarried or civil partners) living together at the same address with children under school leaving age

A young adult, up to the age of 25, who is a jobseeker or in full time education should be included in the family household.

Any other family members should not be included in the Household, even if they share a property with you i.e. please do not include other relatives, such as elderly relatives or siblings that may live with you.

At no time will your information be passed to organisations for marketing or sales purposes or for any commercial use without your prior express consent.
