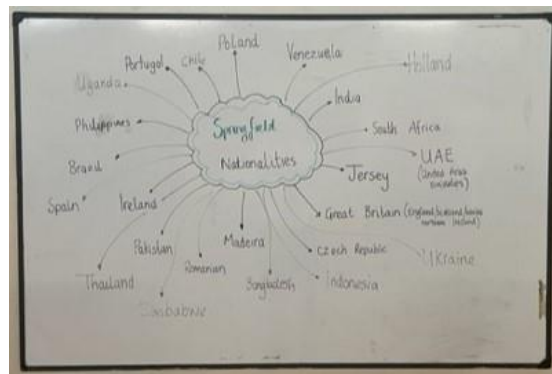

November 18<sup>th</sup>


November 25<sup>th</sup>
